

#### School Rules

- 1. Students have to enter the school in neat and clean uniform.
- 2. Uniform as prescribed has to be worn on all working days.
- 3. Identity card has to be worn daily.
- 4. The students found in improper or untidy uniform will be sent back home.
- 5. No long hair for boys (except sikhs).
- 6. Girls with long hair have to make a plait, girls with short hair to make a ponytail. No other colour band except black will be allowed.
- 7. Application of nail polish or mehndi is strictly prohibited.
- 8. Application of religious tika or bindi with school uniform is strictly prohibited.
- 9. Possession of mobile phones / camera / I pods by students in the campus is strictly prohibited, and if found will be confiscated.
- 10.It is mandatory for students to be regular to school. 75% attendance in each month is compulsory else the student's name would be struck off.
- 11. Students are expected to behave in a righteous manner. Misconduct, use of abusive language or violence of any kind would lead to suspension of the student.
- 12. The use of unfair means in examinations will entail the annulment of the pupil's result.
- 13. Students are not allowed to use the school telephone without the permission of the receptionist. They will not be called to answer phone calls during class hours.
- 14. Discipline must be maintained at all times. Running, loitering, disruptive behaviour or screaming in the school premises will be penalized.
- 15. DPS Shaheedpath is an English medium school and children are expected to speak only in English at all times
- 16. The Almanac is to be brought to school daily.
- 17. Students are expected to reach school 10 minutes before the school begins.

  Students arriving late will not be allowed to enter the school premises without a plausible explanation.
- 18. Tiffin and water bottle to be sent to school along with the students. No tiffin boxes will be accepted during school hours.



- 19. Damage of school property by the student will not be acceptable, charges will be levied.
- 20. If the Identity Card is lost, a new set of identity card can be procured by applying to the school. A duplicate card will be issued on payment of ₹ 100/- (Rupees One hundred only)
- 21. Identity cards are valid for one academic session only and shall be surrendered immediately upon receipt of identity cards for the new session.
- 22. In case the Almanac is lost, another Almanac will be issued on the payment of ₹ 300/- at the office.
- 23. No books, magazines or periodicals (other than text books or library books) are allowed to be brought to school.
- 24. In case of health issues, fever or any other medical condition, the student should not be sent to school.
- 25. The students will not be allowed to go back home during school hours without prior permission of the Principal.
- 26. Expensive articles like fancy watches, transistors, calculator, mobile phones etc. should not be brought to school. They are also not allowed to wear jewellery to school. In case of violation of this rule the articles will be confiscated. The school bears no responsibility for articles lost in the school. In case of a loss, a letter giving details of the loss may be sent to the Class Teacher.
- 27. Proper discipline should be maintained in the school transport.
- 28. If the fees of the student is not paid within one month of the due date, the name of the pupil will be struck off.
- 29. Students are not allowed to go to a relative's/friend's house from school.
- 30. No birthday gifts in any form are allowed. Distribution of any gifts in the school is prohibited. Students need to wear school uniform even on their birthday.
- 31. The students have to bring their instrument to school during the music club.
- 32. The students have to bring their tennis racquets, skates during their specified P. E. periods.

## **Recommendations to Guardians**

- To get the best from the school for your child, you are advised to be in regular touch
  with the school. We earnestly recommend that parents and guardians should look
  into their ward's Almanac every day and see that the lesson and homework assigned
  for the day is done.
- 2. The students should be encouraged to cultivate habit of neatness. Check the uniform, haircut of your ward in the morning.
- 3. Regularity to school should be ensured.
- 4. Remarks put down in diary should be seen and countersigned regularly. It is advisable to write to the class teacher in the Almanac about the problems of your ward/s.
- 5. Contact the Class Teacher on 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Saturday with a prior appointment in case you need to discuss the progress of your ward.
- 6. Ensure that your ward carries books according to the time table.
- 7. Encourage your ward to take a balanced interest in studies, co-curricular activities and sports.
- 8. If your ward is absent from school, he/she must make up for all the work missed by him/her.
- 9. As the medium of instruction in school is English, a regular conversation in English at home will help the child to gain confidence and comprehend the syllabus easily.
- 10. Your ward should be instructed to be careful about his/her things. The name, class and section of the pupil should be clearly marked on all the belongings of the students. Water bottles, blazers and jerseys should also bear the name of the student.
- 11. Kindly check the school ERP for regular updates/notifications and circulars.

## **School Transport Rules**

- Students may avail the school transport, subject to the availability of seats. School transport
  routes are drawn up based on the convenience and demand while ensuring that route is not
  overly long. Parents should consult the school transport in-charge for necessary details or
  any changes desired.
- 2. A student using the school transport is expected to be at the bus stop at least 5 minutes before the scheduled arrival time. The student has to wait on the door opening side of the arriving vehicle.
- 3. Students are issued identity cards. The I-card should be worn by the student before boarding the bus and all through the day till the completion of the return journey.
- 4. Students are allowed to use only their allotted bus and bus stop. No change will be allowed without prior permission of the school in writing.
- 5. Buses will not wait for late comers. If a student misses her/his allotted bus, they should not try to board any other vehicle. It is the responsibility of parents to drop their wards to the school. Such students may, however return by their allotted vehicle.
- 6. Students should stay away from the main road until the vehicle arrives.
- 7. No student should come near the entry door of the vehicle until it comes to a complete halt.
- 8. Boarding and alighting should be done in silence and in an orderly manner.
- 9. All students must occupy the seats allotted immediately after boarding their respective vehicles. The reservation of seats for co-commuters is not allowed under any circumstances.
- 10. Students must not move around in the bus when it is in motion.
- 11. Students must make sure that the aisle of the vehicle is clear, and that school bags and other belongings are placed properly.
- 12. Students must keep all parts of their body inside the vehicle at all times. They should not put their hands out even for waving.
- 13. No object should be thrown inside or outside the vehicle.
- 14. The consumption of edibles and drinks is not permitted in the vehicle.
- 15. Unruly behaviour like shrieking and shouting is strictly prohibited and courteous behaviour by a DPS student is expected at all times.

- 16. The driver's attention must not be distracted for any reason.
- 17. The drivers are authorised to stop buses at designated stops only. The list of stops is prepared keeping in view the convenience and safety of all bus commuters and is always subject to change.
- 18. The teacher and the monitor on duty are responsible for maintaining discipline in the bus.

  Any serious offence will be reported to the Head of School immediately.
- 19. In case of a change in stop and/or bus (of a temporary or permanent nature), permission for the same has to be sought through an application on the prescribed form available at the school administrative office.
- 20. Parents should ensure that their wards do not go to and from bus stops unescorted.
- 21. Parents (or their duly authorised nominee/s) have to produce the identity card at the bus stop or the school gate in order to receive their wards.
- 22. Parents/guardians of students who do not avail the School transport should present themselves at the school gate 10 minutes before the start/dispersal of the school to drop/collect their wards.
- 23. If due to certain exigencies, a student has to leave the school campus during school hours, under her/his own arrangements, the following rules will be observed:
- A written request must be submitted by the parent/guardian.
- The parent's Identity card must be produced.
- The school leaving register must be signed.
- A permission slip must be obtained and shown at the school gate before leaving the campus.
- 24. Application for withdrawal of transport must be submitted in advance.



# Rules of Leave(s) /Absence

- 1. Attendance is compulsory on the first and the last working day of every term.
- 2. Students who have been sick and not attended school for more than 3 days, should bring a medical certificate from their doctor on rejoining school.
- 3. Anyone who has been absent on the previous day will not be admitted to the class without a letter from the parent, addressed to the Class Teacher, stating the reason for absence.
- 4. Leave for going out of station needs prior approval of the Principal.
- 5. In case of an emergency, parents will be informed and they will have to report to the Principal. They are not allowed to enter the classes directly.
- 6. Students suffering from the following diseases must observe the prescribed period of quarantine before returning to class :
- a) Chicken pox Till complete fading of the scabs.
- b) Cholera Till the child is completely well.
- c) Measles Three weeks after the rash disappears.
- d) Mumps Until the swelling has gone, about one month.
- e) Jaundice Six weeks after recovery.
- f) Dengue Till complete recovery.
- g) COVID Till complete recovery.



## **House System**

Class I onwards students are allocated a House, to which they will belong throughout their school tenure. There are four houses in the school. The names and mottos of these houses are as follows:

AGNI (अग्नि)

Each House is headed by the House Captain, a House Vice-Captain and a number of House Prefects. The House Co ordinator is a member of staff, who is In-charge of each House. Several other teachers attached to each of the respective Houses assist the House Co-ordinator. These teachers are called Assistant House Wardens and serve as mentors to the children in their respective group.

Inter House competitions are held in a number of disciplines. Points are awarded to students of each house throughout the year for their individual and collective performance in academics, co-curricular activities, games and sports. These points are summed up at the end of session to decide the champion house.



## **Uniform Rules**

- 1. Students must wear their uniforms with pride and ensure that they look neat and presentable at all times.
- 2. Summer uniform is to be worn at the beginning of the new session.
- 3. No student is allowed to attend any Open House, school function in or outside the school in any dress other than school uniform.
- 4. Napkin is an integral part of the school uniform, hence, the student has to carry it to the school daily.
- 5. It is mandatory for girls to wear white bloomers (with elastic on the thighs) under their skirts/tunics. (for Pre Nursery to V)

# **Fee Payment**

- Fees can be deposited in advance, for any number of months or the entire academic year if so desired.
- In case of non-payment of fees for more than one month, the student concerned will be
  debarred from taking any tests/semester exams. In case the outstanding dues exceed
  2 months, the name of the student will be struck off from the school roll. This provision will
  also apply in case the late fee is not paid in full.
- Parents must preserve their copies of the fee receipt as proof of payment, since these may have to be produced in case of any dispute.
- In case of dishonor of cheque, a fee of ₹ 500/- towards bank and administrative charges would be charged along with the late fine, as may be applicable.

- There will be a fine imposed, according to the following criteria, if the fee is paid after the due date. ₹ 500/- after 15<sup>th</sup> every month; ₹ 500/- per week after 31<sup>st</sup> every month.
- Fees can be paid at school office on all working days.
- Please note that no invoice or reminder will be issued with respect to fee payment dates.



# **Visiting Hours & Open House**

#### **Visiting Hours**

The school would like parents to maintain a close rapport with their ward's teachers and meet them periodically. The Head of School and members of the faculty will make every effort to make themselves available to meet parents on request, at mutually convenient time on working days, by prior appointment. Parents can call up the school in advance to ask for an appointment and visit the school only after being given a confirmed time and date.

#### **Open House**

'Open House' is held to facilitate discussion between parents and teachers on the child's progress. Parents will be given specific timings to meet their child's teachers on Open House days. They must be punctual as per the schedule. Please note that it is mandatory for parents to attend the Open House. Children must accompany their parents for the Open House, dressed in school uniform and carry their I-Card and Almanac.




