

SCHOOL RULES

- 1. Students have to enter the school in neat and clean uniform.
- 2. Uniform as prescribed has to be worn on all working days.
- 3. Identity card has to be worn daily to school.
- 4. The students found in improper or untidy uniform will be sent back home.
- 5. No long hair for boys (except sikhs).
- 6. Girls with long hair have to make two plaits, girls with short hair to use a black hair band. No other colour band except black will be allowed.
- 7. Application of nail polish or mehndi is strictly prohibited.
- 8. Application of religious tikka or bindi with school uniform is strictly prohibited.
- 9. Possession of mobile phones / camera / I pods by students in the campus is strictly prohibited, and if found will be confiscated.
- 10. It is mandatory for students to be regular to school. 75% attendance in each month is compulsory else the student's name would be struck off.
- 11. Students are expected to behave in a righteous manner. Misconduct, use of abusive language or violence of any kind would lead to suspension of the student.
- 12. The use of unfair means in examinations, test will entail the annulment of the pupil's result.
- 13. Students are not allowed to use the school telephone without the permission of the receptionist. They will not be called to answer phone calls during class hours.
- 14. Discipline must be maintained at all times running, loitering, disruptive behavior screaming in the school premises will be penalized.
- 15. DPS Shaheedpath is an English medium school and pupil are expected to speak only in English at all times.



- 16. The Almanac is to be brought to school daily.
- 17. Tiffin and water bottle to be sent to school along with the students, no tiffin boxes will be accepted during school hours.
- 18. Damage of school property by the student will not be acceptable, charges will be levied.
- 19. No books, magazines or periodicals (other than text books or library books) are allowed to be bought to school.
- 20. In case of health issues, fever or any other medical condition, the student should not be sent to school.
- 21. The students will not be allowed to go back home during school hours without prior permission of the Principal.
- 22. Expensive items or money (except for canteen) should not be sent to school.
- 23. Proper discipline should be maintained in the school transport.
- 24. If the fees of the student is not paid within one month of the due date, the name of the pupil will be struck off.
- 25. Students are not allowed to go to a relative/friend's house from school.
- 26. No birthday gifts in any form are allowed. Distribution of any gifts in the school is prohibited. Students need to wear school uniform even on their birthday.
- 27. The students have to bring their instrument to school during the music club.
- 28. The students have to bring their tennis racquets, skates during their specified P. E. periods.

RECOMMENDATIONS TO GUARDIANS

To get the best from the school for your child, you are advised to be in regular touch with the school. We earnestly recommend that parents and guardians should look into their ward's Almanac every day and see that the lesson and homework assigned for the day is done.

- 1. The students should be encouraged to cultivate habit of neatness. Check the uniform, haircut and punctuality of your ward in the morning.
- 2. Remarks put down in diary should be seen and countersigned regularly. It is advisable to write to the class teacher in the Almanac about the problems of your ward/s.
- 3. Contact the Class Teacher on Monday, Wednesday, Friday after school in case you need to discuss the progress of your ward.
- 4. See that your ward carries books according to the Time Table for the day.
- 5. Children will not be allowed to go home during school hours. Parents are requested not to make any social engagements or medical appointments during working hours. To ensure discipline, parents are requested not to send their wards to school on the day they have any such appointments.
- 6. Encourage your ward to take a balanced interest in studies, co-curricular activities and sports.
- 7. If your ward is absent from school he/she must complete all the work missed by him/her, at the earliest.
- 8. As the medium of instruction in school is English, a regular conversation in English at home will help the child to gain confidence and comprehends the syllabus easily.
- 9. Parents are prohibited from going directly to the class to meet the teachers or the children.



- 10. Expensive articles like fancy watches, transistors, calculator, mobile phones etc. should not be brought to school. They are also not allowed to wear jewellery to school. In case of violation of this rule the articles will be confiscated. The school bears no responsibility for articles lost in the school. In case of a loss, a letter giving details of the loss may be sent to the Class Teacher.
- 11. Students who come to school escorted will not be allowed to leave before the escort arrives. In case of delay, they should report to the school office.
- 12. The school reserves the right to suspend students whose progress in studies is unsatisfactory or whose conduct is harmful to other students.
- 13. Parents and guardians are not allowed to visit their wards or teachers without prior permission of the Principal.
- 14. Parents and guardians of all students have to attend all the PTM to note the progress of their wards.
- 15. Your ward should be instructed to be careful about his/her things. The name, class and section of the pupil should be clearly marked on all the belongings of the students.

 Water bottles, blazers and jerseys should also bear the name of the student.
- 16. Students have to attend all the teaching, games, library and activity period in the school.
- 17. A student who uses unfair means during tests will be given zero in the subject with a warning letter. Repetition of the same will result in suspension.
- 18. The school reserves the right to withhold the promotion of the student in case of under performance.

School Transport Rules

- 1. Students may avail the school transport, subject to the availability of seats. School transport routes are drawn up based on the convenience and demand while ensuring that route is not overly long. Parents should consult the school transport in-charge for necessary details or any changes desired.
- 2. A student using the school transport is expected to be at the bus stop at least 5 minutes before the scheduled arrival time. The student has to wait on the door opening side of the arriving vehicle.
- 3. Students are issued identity cards. The I-card should be worn by the student before boarding the bus and all through the day till the completion of the return journey.
- 4. Students are allowed to use only their allotted bus and bus stop. No change will be allowed without prior permission of the school in writing.
- 5. Buses will not wait for late comers. If a student misses her/his allotted bus, they should not try to board any other vehicle. It is the responsibility of parents to drop their wards to the school. Such students may, however return by their allotted vehicle.
- 6. Students should stay away from the main road until the vehicle arrives.
- 7. No student should come near the entry door of the vehicle until it comes to a complete halt.
- 8. Boarding and alighting should be done in silence and in an orderly manner.
- 9. All students must occupy the seats allotted immediately after boarding their respective vehicles. The reservation of seats for co-commuters is not allowed under any circumstances.
- 10. Students must not move around in the bus when it is in motion.
- 11. Students must make sure that the aisle of the vehicle is clear, and that school bags and other belongings are placed properly.
- 12. Students must keep all parts of their body inside the vehicle at all times. They should not put their hands out even for waving.
- 13. No object should be thrown inside or outside the vehicle.
- 14. The consumption of edibles and drinks is not permitted in the vehicle.
- 15. Unruly behavior like shrieking and shouting is strictly prohibited and courteous behavior by a DPS student is expected at all times.



- 16. The driver's attention must not be distracted for any reason.
- 17. The drivers are authorised to stop buses at designated stops only. The list of stops is prepared keeping in view the convenience and safety of all bus commuters and is always subject to change.
- 18. The teacher and the monitor on duty are responsible for maintaining discipline in the bus.

 Any serious offence will be reported to the Head of School immediately.
- 19. In case of a change in stop and/or bus (of a temporary or permanent nature), permission for the same has to be sought through an application on the prescribed form available at the school administrative office.
- 20. Parents should ensure that their wards do not go to and from bus stops unescorted.
- 21. Parents (or their duly authorised nominee/s) have to produce the identity card at the bus stop or the school gate in order to receive their wards.
- 22. If the Identity Card is lost, a new set of identity card can be procured by applying to the school on the prescribed form, available at the school administrative office, along with the remaining card and administrative charges of **Rs. 200/-** (Rupees two hundred only)
- 23. Parents/guardians of students who do not avail the School transport should present themselves at the school gate 10 minutes before the start/dispersal of the school to drop/collect their wards.
- 24. Identity cards are valid for one academic session only and shall be surrendered immediately upon receipt of identity cards for the new session.
- 25. If due to certain exigencies, a student has to leave the school campus during school hours, under her/his own arrangements, the following rules will be observed:
- A written request must be submitted by the parent/guardian.
- The parent's Identity card must be produced.
- The school leaving register must be signed.
- A permission slip must be obtained and shown at the school gate before leaving the campus.
- 26. Application for withdrawal of transport must be submitted in advance.



School Library Rules

The school library is open to all bonafide students of the school. Students visiting the library have to observe the following rules:

- 1. Strict silence must be maintained in the library.
- 2. Students are **not allowed** to enter the library with their **bags**.
- 3. Students are not allowed to bring their personal books or belongings to the library except library notebook and pencil.
- 4. The library has an **open access system**, and the students must help to maintain the order and organization of the collection in different shelves.
- 5. All the books that are issued need to be duly entered. No one is permitted to take any book from the library without the permission of the librarian.
- 6. Books will be issued to students to take home from class IV onwards only.
- 7. Reference books are not for issue, these books can be read in the library only.
- 8. Books will be issued/returned to the students only in their scheduled library period.
- 9. Students are not eligible for fresh issue, until the previous issued book is returned.
- 10. All the books shall be issued for the **7 days** only.
- 11. If books are returned late without valid reason, the borrowing facility will be withdrawn for a period of 4 weeks or more. Late fine of Rs.5/ per day per book shall be charged.
- 12. Books marked ,disfigured or damaged while in the possession of the students will have to be replaced by the borrower.
- 13. Any student found deliberately damaging or defacing a book may be debarred from the library for the entire term or academic year.
- 14. Books must be returned **15 days** prior to the beginning of examination, else they will not be allowed to appear for the examination.
- 15. Students must take "NO DUES" from library before taking marksheets and transfer certificate.



RULES of LEAVE/ABSENCE

- 1. Attendance is compulsory on the first and the last working day of every term.
- 2. Students who have been sick and not attended school for more than 3 days should bring a medical certificate from their doctor on rejoining school.
- 3. Parents should fill up "Record for Non-Attendance" for each day the student has been absent from school along with stating the reasons for absence.
- 4. Anyone who has been absent on the previous day will not be admitted to the class without a letter from the parent, addressed to the Class Teacher, stating the reason for absence.
- 5. Leave for going out of station needs prior approval of the Principal.
- 6. In case of an emergency, parents will be informed and they will have to report to the Principal. They are not allowed to enter the classes directly.
- 7. Students suffering from the following diseases must observe the prescribed period of quarantine before returning to class :
- a) Chicken pox Till complete fading of the scabs.
- b) Cholera Till the child is completely well.
- c) Measles Three weeks after the rash disappears.
- d) Mumps Untill the swelling has gone, about one month.
- e) Jaundice Six weeks after recovery.
- f) Dengue Till complete recovery.



House System

Class I onwards students are allocated a House, to which they will belong throughout their school tenure. There are four houses in the school. The names and mottos of these houses are as follows:

Each House is headed by the House Captain, a House Vice-Captain and a number of House Prefects. The House Co ordinator is a member of staff, who is In-charge of each House. Several other teachers attached to each of the respective Houses assist the House Co-ordinator. These teachers are called Assistant House Wardens and serve as mentors to the children in their respective group. They are responsible for each of the students in their respective Group and looking after their general well-being, as well as their academic, sports and co-curricular performance.

Inter House competitions are held in a number of disciplines. Points are awarded to students of each house throughout the year for their individual and collective performance in academics, co-curricular activities, games and sports. These points are summed up at the end of session to decide the champion house.



School Uniform Rules

- 1. Students must wear their uniforms with pride and ensure that they look neat and presentable at all times.
- 2. Summer uniform is to be worn at the beginning of the new session.
- 3. No student is allowed to attend any Open House, school function in or outside the school in any dress other than school uniform.
- 4. Napkin is an integral part of the school uniform and hence the student has to carry it to the school daily.
- 5. It is mandatory for girls to wear white bloomers (with elastic on the thighs) under their skirts/tunics)

Fee Payment

- Fees can be deposited in advance, for any number of months or the entire academic year if so desired.
- In case of non-payment of fees for more than one month the student concerned will be debarred from taking any tests/semester exams. In case the outstanding dues exceed
 2 months, the name of the defaulting student will be struck off from the school roll.
 This provision will also apply in case the late fee is not paid in full.
- Parents must preserve their copies of the fee receipt as proof of payment, since these may have to be produced in case of any dispute.
- In case of dishonor of cheque, a fee of Rs. 500 towards bank and administrative charges would be charged along with the late fine, as may be applicable.


