
- w. To take over, manage or combine, whether by affiliation or otherwise, with any other institution for the furtherance of all or any of its objects.

- The Trustees shall be entitled and have liberty to accept gifts, voluntary contributions from any person, firm or institutions or Government, Central Government to augment the Trust fund such money for the objects of the Trust.
- aa. To establish, develop, maintain and grant aid in cash or in kind to hospitals, medical schools, medical Colleges, nursing institutions, dispensaries, universities homes, child welfare centers and/or such other similar charitable institutions in India for the benefit and use of the general public.
 - bb. To establish, run support and grant or other financial assistance to schools, colleges, libraries, reading rooms, universities, laboratories, research and other institutions of the nature in India, for use of the students and the staff and also for the development and advancement of education and diffusion of knowledge amongst the public of general
 - cc. i/o establish, maintain and run scholarships, scholarships, and render other kind of aid to students including supply of books stipends, medical & other incentives to study, without any distinction as to caste color . race, creed or sex.
 - dd. To promote, establish, maintain or grant aid to institutions for the promotion of science, literature, music, drama and fine arts for the preservation of historical monuments and for the research & other institutions in India, having similar object for the benefit of the public in general.
 - ee. To establish, maintain or grant aid for the establishment and or maintenance of parks, gardens, gymsnasiums, sport clubs, dharamashas, and rest houses, for use by public in general.
 - ff. To establish, maintain or grant aid to home for the aged, orphanages or other establishments for the relief and help to the poor, needy and destitute people, orphans, widows and aged persons.
 - gg. To establish and develop institutions for the physically handicapped and disabled or mentally retarded persons and to provide them education, food, clothing, or other help.
 - hh. To grant relief and assistance to the needy victims during natural calamities such as famine, earthquake, food, fire, pestilence etc. and to give donations and other assistance to institutions, establishment or person engaged in such relief works.
 - ii. To construct, repair and maintain the temples, cemeteries and burial grounds.
 - jj. To grant aid or render assistance to other public charitable trusts or institutions.

Management of the trust shall rest on the board of trustees which shall comprise of the three permanent trustees and of at least two more trustees that represented or co-opted. However in no case the number of trustees shall increase? (seven)

FIRST TRUSTEES.

1. Mr. Jaydantilal Patel, Chairman of the board of trustees during his life time
2. Mrs. Shekhatlal Patel, Vice Chairman of the board of trustees during his life time
3. Mr. Abhishek Patel, Secretary cum treasurer of the board of trustees during his lifetime

TERMS OF THE OFFICE OF THE TRUSTEES.

The terms of the permanent trustees shall be for life. The terms of office in the case of nominated or co-opted trustees shall also be 3 years. Terms of the co-opted trustees shall be the left over period of the trustees in whose place the new trustee will be appointed. Thereafter they will be eligible for reappointment. The chairman is endowed with the power to remove the tenure of the nominated trustees or suspend and/or dismiss them at any time without assigning any reason. The decision of the chairman in this regard shall be final and binding.

VACANCIES:

- i. A Trustee shall cease to be in office with immediate effect on his becoming insolvent or insane or of on being convicted for any offences involving moral turpitude or at resignation either will be eligible for reappointment. The chairman is endowed with the power to review the tenure of the nominated trustees or suspend and/or dismiss them at any time without assigning any reason. The decision of the chairman in this regard shall be final and binding.
- ii. If he without leave of absence does not attend three consecutive meetings of the trustees or for one calendar year, whichever is longer. Or
- iii. If he is requested to resign by 3/4th or as near thereto as possible of the remaining trustees. The permanent trustees shall fill any vacancy occurring in the office of Trustees including those caused by retirement, either voluntary or with the consent of the majority. The chairman of vacancies in the office of the Trustees shall not invalidate any act or decision by the Board of Trustees.
- iv. Any vacancies of permanent trustees whether on his / her resignation or otherwise shall be filled by the linear descendants of Mr Jaydantilal Patel (Author permanent trustee)

The Trustees may inform time to time delegate to any one of them or to any other person or committee, such of their power and duties, as they deem fit, subject to nevertheless to, their retaining the ultimate control and supervision. The Trustees shall work in an honorary capacity, but they shall be entitled to reimbursement expenses incurred by them in the conduct of their duties or in promotion of the objects of the Trust or etc. behalf of the Trust. No trustee shall be entitled to take loans from the Trust or to take any advantage for himself or any member of his family in whatever form it manner from the Trust.

- A Trustee who by his conduct as a trustee or in his personal life adversely reflects on the reputation of the trust may be asked by the Board of Trustees to "resign" passed by a majority to submit his resignation, failing which he shall cease to be a Trustee with effect from the date of passing of such resolution.
 - The Trustees may institute, conduct, defend, compound or abandon any legal procedure by or against the Trust or Trustees and allow time and diligence for payment or satisfaction of any debt due or for any claims or demands by or against the Trust.

The Trustees of the Trust may obtain payments of money from all Courts and Departments of the State and Central Government including local authority and authorities

The Trustees of the Trust may purchase, construct, alter, lease, rent partly or fully immovable or movable property from time to time. They shall have the power to sell immovable or movable property of the Trust by two third majority in the best interest of the Trust as and when necessary and to use these proceeds for the objects of the Trust only.

The Trustees may authorise any of the Trustees by way of resolution signed by the chairman to appear before the registrar or sub registrar or any other authority appointed for registration of deeds, documents and other instruments and to execute, present, admin. and register or cause to be registered any deed, document etc. in which the Trust is interested or involved.

Every Trustee will be at liberty to resign on giving one month's notice of his intention to do so.

MEETINGS :-

- i. The Trustee may meet together as and when they may think necessary. But they shall hold at least one meeting in a year.
- ii. The Quorum at a meeting of the Trustees shall be of three, when the strength of the Trustees is four. The quorum shall be five if the strength is more than four.
- iii. The Chairman of the Trust shall preside over all meetings of the Trust. In case he is not present, the Trustees present may elect one of them as Chairman of that meeting but the presence of two of the permanent trustees is a must. The trustees shall act according to the decisions of the majority of the Trustees. When the Trustees are not unanimous the Chairman shall have the casting vote in case of a tie.
- iv. There will be no need of a quorum for adjourned meeting wherein agenda of last meeting will be discussed or decided. Non-attendance of any one of the permanent trustees is mandatory in the adjourned meeting.

- i. A resolution passed by circulation by the majority of the Trustees and effective as a resolution passed at a meeting of Trustees
- ii. Minute book shall be provided and kept by the trustees and all the proceedings of meeting of the trustees shall be regularly recorded in the minute book by the secretary, if any, or in his absence by some one to whom the chairman may appoint for the meeting at the conclusion thereof or at a subsequent meeting when they are duly confirmed.

An account of all the money received and spent for and on behalf of the trust shall be maintained, a balance sheet shall be prepared at the end of each year and the account book shall be kept at the office of the trust under the supervision of the secretary and shall be open to inspection by every trustee during office hours.

One or more account shall be opened and kept with one or more banks as may be selected by the trustees from time to time.

- All cheques and orders for the withdrawing of the money from the accounts of the trust shall be signed by two of the trustees, or chairman and one trustee nominated for the purpose by the trustees under their joint signature.
- The board of trustees may from time to time may prescribe or alter rules for the management and administration of the trust for convening and holding of the meetings of the trust and conduct of business thereof, and they may delegate any of their powers and duties to sub-committees consisting of such authors as they may appoint for such purposes.

The trustees shall not be liable for any loss not attributed to their own dishonesty. No proceeding against a trustee shall be taken for any alleged breach of trust except on a decision arrived at by the board of trustees at a special meeting convened for the purpose.

The trustees shall provide and cause to be deposited and kept in a safe place all deeds, minute books and other documents of, or relating to, the trust proceedings on behalf of the trust.

DUTIES OF THE OFFICE BEARERS

CHAIRMAN: The chairman shall act as the constitutional head of the trust and in all matters of basic and fundamental nature he guides in the board of trustees and of a routine character by himself and shall have the following powers:-

- i. The power to call an emergency meeting of the board of trustees

- ii. To preside over all meetings of the board of trustees and all general meetings shall control or regulate the business at such meetings in the best interests of the trust.
- VICE-CHAIRMAN** - The vice chairman shall perform the duties and exercise the rights of the Chairman in his absence.
- SECRETARY-CASH-TRASURER**: These Secretary-cash-Treasurer shall be the principal executive officer of the trust and shall carry on all its business subject to such directions, if any, as the board of trustee may from time to time issue.
- i. Preserve the record of the trust.
 - ii. Convene all meetings of the board of trustees.
 - iii. Conduct all elections.
 - iv. Generally give prompt effect to the resolutions passed at the meetings of the trust.

DISQUALIFICATION OF THE TRUSTEE

- i. A trustee shall cease to be a Trustee of the trust if a competent authority, in respect of heinous crime, revicts him.
- ii. Is declared insane or insolvent.
- iii. If he misappropriates, misuses, fails or refuses to account for the property under his care, causing the shadow on his integrity and honesty in the estimation of the chairman.
- iv. Held by the chairman to be "involved directly or indirectly in the activities bringing bad name to the trust."

The chairman may terminate the trusteeship of such person without assigning any reason thereof.

POWERS, DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS OF THE OFFICE BEARERS:

CHAIRMAN

- a. The Chairman shall preside over all the meetings of the General Body.
- b. The Chairman shall be the executive head of the trust; he shall function for and on behalf of the trust during the absence of the council. All such action for and decision regarding all matter is final and binding. All the other office bearer shall bring up to the notice of the council for its approval in due course. But his function under his guidance.
- c. He will jointly operate the joint account with the treasurer or secretary.

VICE-CHAIRMAN IN ABSENCE OF THE CHAIRMAN - Vice chairman shall act as Chairman.



S E C R E T A R Y:

The secretary shall carry on correspondence on behalf of the trust, implement the decision of the board of trustee and chairman. He shall issue notices of the meeting, prepare the annual reports, consult with authority, objection and take the advice of the president on matters effecting the policy of the society.

- The office of the trustee shall be honorary but the trustee be entitled to be paid their actual travelling expenses and other incidental charges incurred by them in attending the meeting or in connection with carrying out the object of the trust
- The funds and the income of the trust shall be solely utilized towards the achievement of the object and no portion of it shall be utilized for payment to the trustees by way of profit, dividend etc.

No income of the trust shall be applied for the personal benefit of the trustees

A trustee shall be accountable only for such money, stocks, shares and funds as shall actually come in to their hands & a trustee, shall not be answerable or accountable for neglect, default, acts or omission or commission of the other trustees, nor of any banker or other person with whom the trust properties or its securities may have been deposited or kept

The trustees shall have the power to determine increase of doubt whether any money or property shall for the purpose of the charity be considered as capital or income, any expenses or outgoing ought to be paid or borne and every such determination shall be binding and conclusive provided that nothing contained shall be deemed to authorize the trustees to spend the income or corpus of the trust for any purpose not authorized by these present

INVEST OF TRUST FUND:

Subject to provision of this trust deed, the board of trustees may invest the fund from time to time in any securities authorized by the Indian Trusts Act, 1882 'or' in such shares or securities as the board of trustees may in their discretion think fit without being liable for loss.

THE ACCOUNTS AND MINUTES:

The trustees shall maintain true & correct accounts of all receipts payments & dealings in regard to the trust property and shall also maintain the correct record of their meetings & deliberations

INDEMNITY:

The trustee shall be fully kept indemnified and harmless by the trust against any action or claim, loss suffered or liability arising against them in good faith pursuant to the powers and authority conferred on them by these presents

The Board of trustee shall have all such powers and shall perform all its functions as are necessary or proper for the achievement of the purpose of the trust.
